Chapter By-Laws Adopted July 31, 2009 Revised March 18, 2010

The by-laws established by this chapter are to be honored and observed by ALL chapter officers and members. Any person found in violation of any of the accepted by-laws will be suspended from any activities of the Chapter for thirty days at which time the members will vote to retain accused person or cancel their membership. If membership is discontinued no refund of dues paid shall be made.

1. All members must be saved by the Blood of Jesus Christ and make a public profession of their faith.
2. Members must completely agree with the "Statement of Faith" established by the National Organization of the CBA.
3. Each Member should attend or be a member of a local church body.
4. Member dues and donations shall not be considered as part of their yearly tithes to their local church.
5. Any officer or candidate for office must be a member of the CBA before consideration can be determined and appointment made.
6. **Chapter officers, as required by the CBA policy, shall be Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer. The Chair reserves the right to add additional positions as needed.**
7. **The term of all offices shall be two (2) years.**
8. **Officers will be elected/re-elected by nomination and vote by the chapter members.**
9. **Approved officers will be required to maintain a two (2) year chapter membership and CBA membership and pay the appropriate dues at the start of their office term.**
10. **In the event of an office vacancy, the officers will recommend a member to fulfill the original officer term. The chapter will then vote on the recommendation.**
11. We are not a club but a Ministry for Jesus Christ; only here to spread the word of His grace and salvation to sinners going to a Devil's Hell.
12. By being a non-denominational ministry, there will be no debates about personal interpretations of any members.

13. When operating a booth at an event, at no time should one's denominational beliefs be imposed upon a prospect for salvation in Jesus Christ. However, if a candidate asks what would be a good church to attend, the chapter member should name all the churches that are devoted to the True Word of God and salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ. This way the Prospect can decide which denomination they would prefer.
14. Only Members of the Chapter are allowed to man a booth at local events.
15. Proper dress apparel shall be worn at all public events. No holes or excessive stains on jeans or shirts. No tank tops or sleeve less shirts. No logos or labels on shirts or hats that does not portray a witness for Christ.
16. There should be no more than three members at a booth at any given time.
17. If two members are a couple, they will be scheduled to work a booth together.
18. We will have a donation box on the layout table, but at no time should event workers ask for donations or try to solicit any funds.
19. If someone comes to the booth for information; all attention will be directed to that person.
20. If someone approaches the booth and is disorderly in anyway, then one person should politely ask the person if they could talk away from the booth. By all means, do not indulge in a heated debate at the booth.
21. No drink bottles, food wrappers or any paraphernalia that does not relate to the ministry witness shall be in public view.
22. No use of tobacco products will be permitted while at the booth or in view of the public.
23. No profanity or aggressive conversations shall take place while in any environment pertaining to the Ministry in the public view (i.e. meeting, fundraisers, shooting events, etc...)
24. No purchases for reimbursement shall be obtained until approved by the Chairman first.
25. Member payments for dues and monetary donations made to the Chapter will be summarized and issued a statement of deductions to be applied to the member's tax return by January of the New Year.
26. The Chapter By-Laws cannot be modified or corrected without complete approval from all four chapter officers and an approval by 2/3 majority vote of the chapter members.
27. During a business meeting, in the event that there is a tied vote on a motion, the chairman shall make the tie-breaking decision.

The by-laws established by this chapter of the CBA are no different than the code of ethics that we as Christians should up-hold daily. We are all children of God, and brothers and sister in Jesus Christ. We should portray our Christian witness at all times and support each other in our walk for Jesus.
